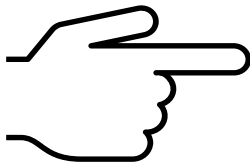


Residential Building Permit Application Checklist

Building Plans are required. While it is not required to have them professionally or computer drawn, it is recommended.

- Completed Residential Building Permit Application Form
- Certificate of survey
 - Required for new homes
 - If parcel is greater than 5 acres, a site staking certificate may be allowed.
 - See FAQ for Certificate of Survey Requirements
- Approved land use permit from Sherburne County, if applicable.
 - Check Beacon website, <https://beacon.schneidercorp.com/>
- Septic Compliance – contact office if you are unsure of when this was last completed.
 - New homes require a septic permit application at the time of new home permit application.
- Two sets of paper building plans drawn to scale.
 - If greater than 11 x 17 in size, a digital copy is required. Email to permits@beckertownship.org with owner name and address/site location in the subject line.
- Property owner waiver if no contractor
- Supplemental worksheet if adding a deck or above ground pool
 - See pool or deck FAQ's
- Energy Code Calculations – required for new homes.
- Driveway installation information if applicable.
 - New homes get one driveway with the parcel.
 - Sherburne County requires separate application if abutting a County Road.
 - Be sure elevations and location appear on certificate of survey.
- Soil borings when required – all new homes require a soil boring at the house pad location unless data is contained in the preliminary plat.
- Other documentation and information requested by the Township and reasonably necessary for adequate review and evaluation.



Once the new home construction is complete, an As-built Certificate of Survey is required. Please allow up to one week for review of the survey. Requesting/obtaining this document is the responsibility of whoever pulls the permit. A certificate of occupancy will not be issued until after the As-built Certificate of Survey is approved.
