


## **Residential Building Permit Application Checklist**

Building Plans are required. While it is not required to have them professionally or computer drawn, it is recommended.

Completed Residential Building Permit Application Form
Certificate of survey
<ul> <li>Required for new homes</li> </ul>
o If parcel is greater than 5 acres, a site staking certificate may be allowed.
<ul> <li>See FAQ for Certificate of Survey Requirements</li> </ul>
Approved land use permit from Sherburne County, if applicable.
<ul> <li>Check Beacon website, <a href="https://beacon.schneidercorp.com/">https://beacon.schneidercorp.com/</a></li> </ul>
Septic Compliance – contact office if you are unsure of when this was last completed.
<ul> <li>New homes require a septic permit application at the time of new home permit</li> </ul>
application.
o If greater than 11 x 17 in size, a digital copy is required. Email to
permits@beckertownship.org with owner name and address/site location in the
subject line.

Supplemental worksheet if adding a deck or above ground pool
<ul> <li>See pool or deck FAQ's</li> </ul>
Energy Code Calculations – required for new homes.
Driveway installation information if applicable.
<ul> <li>New homes get one driveway with the parcel.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Sherburne County requires separate application if abutting a County Road.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Be sure elevations and location appear on certificate of survey.</li> </ul>
Soil borings when required – all new homes require a soil boring at the house pad location
unless data is contained in the preliminary plat.
Other documentation and information requested by the Township and reasonably necessary
for adequate review and evaluation.



Once the new home construction is complete, an As-built Certificate of Survey is required. Please allow up to one week for review of the survey. Requesting/obtaining this document is the responsibility of whoever pulls the permit. A certificate of occupancy will not be issued until after the As-built Certificate of Survey is approved.
